Chapter 33 Post 9-11 GI Bill®

This benefit will cover required tuition/fees according to the eligibility % stated on the Certificate of Eligibility (COE) for up to the 2023-2024 cap of \$27,120.05. The Yellow Ribbon Program is an available funding source for tuition/fees that exceed the cap. Parking Permit, Health Insurance, Fines, and On Campus Room and Board are not covered. This benefit does come with a Monthly Housing Allowance (MHA) for eligible persons. A book stipend is also provided. For more information on payment rates, please visit va.gov/education/.

Yellow Ribbon Program

For eligible Chapter 33 Post 9-11 GI Bill® users, the yellow ribbon program allows private schools and VA to fund the tuition and fee cost that exceed the annual cap of \$26,381.37.
