SketchUp Part 1

This course is an introduction to SketchUp tools used to create 3-D models from Floor plans and generate 3 D Views. Suggestions for course assignments will be given.

SketchUp Part 2

This course builds upon Part 1 using more advanced tools including materials, textures, modeling furniture and project presentation. Suggestions for course assignments will be given.

Advanced SketchUp (Part 3)

This course will build upon one's current base knowledge of SketchUp to show additional techniques and short cuts.

Enscape

This introductory course will give hands-on explanation of how to create realistic renderings. Prior knowledge of Revit is necessary.

Space Planning

This introductory class will cover the basics of designing interior spaces based upon the functions required within a space and basic room layouts. Suggestions for course assignments will be given.

Lighting & Electrical

This course explains the basic symbols and strategies for designing lighting and electrical in residential design, and how these are communicated via a lighting and electrical plan. Suggestions of course assignments will be given.

Hand Sketching Interiors

This class will teach the basics of one point and two-point perspective in creating quick interior sketches.

Introduction to Building Codes & Standards

This class will introduce the building codes and accessibility standards used in the building professions. Suggestions of course assignments will be given.

Wellness and Sustainability

This class will explain how human well-being and sustainability are interconnected, the latest research on designing for well-being, and the most up to date information on sustainability. This is an introductory course, and no prior knowledge is required. Suggestions of course assignments will be given.

Digital and Physical Board Construction

This class will cover techniques and tools used in Digital and Physical Board Construction. Each student will construct a board of a given plan. Suggestions for course assignments will be given.

Classes are only open to individuals 18 years and older. Participants do not receive college credit for these classes. Face to Face.
