Students taking Main Campus Undergraduate and graduate coursework must complete this form to be awarded summer financial assistance. This application is required if a student is pursuing summer loans or work-study only.

Application Process:

- Complete your 2009-2010 financial aid file (including your 2009-2010 FAFSA, 2009-2010 Student Information Form and any other requested documents). FAFSA applications are available online at www.fafsa.ed.gov and UIW required forms are on our website at www.uiw.edu/finaid under the 'Forms' link.
- Register for at least 6 undergraduate or 4 graduate hours over all the summer sessions in order to use Federal loans. You will not be awarded summer assistance prior to summer enrollment.**
- Submit the 2009 Financial Assistance Summer Application once your 2009-2010 financial aid file and Summer 2009 registration is complete.
- Notify the OFA of any change in your housing, enrollment or outside resources (scholarships, tuition reimbursement, and discounts on tuition). Please note that any of these changes may affect your award.

What funds are available?

Summer financial aid includes loans (federal or private) and work-study (if eligible). Grant assistance under the ContinUIW program is also available **for undergraduate students only** (\$1000 for 3 hours, \$1500 for 6 hours and \$2000 for 9 hours, along with an additional \$500 for students living on campus). ContinUIW funds are open to students completing at least 12 undergraduate main campus hours in Fall 2008 and 12 in Spring 2009, with a cumulative 2.5 gpa.

Can I use Federal Stafford Loans?

Yes, however it decreases the total amount you will have available in the Fall and/or Spring. Stafford loan limits are determined annually, and so any amount borrowed in summer decreases the amount left to borrow in fall and spring. For example, if you are eligible for \$3500 in Stafford funds for the 2009-2010 academic year and you borrow \$1000 in Stafford funds for Summer 2009, then you would have a remaining eligibility of \$2500 for Fall 2009 and Spring 2010. **You may need to find a way to replace Stafford funds used in the Summer with additional loan assistance or personal payments during the Fall and/or Spring.**
