San Antonio Legal Secretaries Association (SALSA) Scholarship (Deadline 12/18/2009)

SALS is offering a \$750 scholarship to San Antonio area college students. The scholarship is open to students who: have at least a 3.0 GPA; can demonstrate good character; have a documented history of participation in extracurricular activities; and have and have demonstrated financial need (must have a FAFSA on file with the school).

Assistance League of San Antonio (ALSA) Scholarship Program (Deadline 02/26/2010)

ALSA is offering a \$2,000 scholarship to students entering their junior or senior year in a four year college or university in Bexar County. The scholarship is open to students who: have completed a minimum of 60 hours of college credit at the time of application; are enrolled for a minimum of 12 hours of credit at a 4 year college or university in Bexar County; and have a minimum college GPA of 3.0.

Applicants must submit a completed ALSA Scholarship application (found online at www.assistanceleaguesa.org) and a biographical letter of no more than one typed page which

includes information regarding your family or background and educational goals. Applicants must also provide a letter of acceptance from a 4 year college or university in Bexar County and information on the date you will begin attending. The application and biography must be accompanied by a minimum of three letters of recommendation (2 from professors and one from other school personnel or employers).

American Institute of CPA's Scholarship Programs (Deadlines Vary by Program-See Below)

The AICPA is pleased to offer several academic scholarships for students interested in accounting and business:

- **AICPA/Accountemps Student Scholarship (Deadline 4/1/2010)** - a joint program with Accountemps, awarding five \$2,500 scholarships to students pursuing a degree in accounting, finance or information systems.
- **John L. Carey Scholarship (Deadline 4/1/2010)** - \$5,000 scholarships for up to 10 liberal arts or other non-business related degree holders preparing to enter a graduate accounting program.
- **AICPA Scholarship for Minority Accounting Students (Deadline 3/15/2010)** - financial awards of up to \$5,000 for undergraduate and graduate minority accounting students.
