



KEMPER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Kemper Scholarship Program encourages first year students' appreciation of the liberal arts while providing experiences, contacts, and training that may lead to careers in administration or business.

Scholars will receive scholarship grants from \$2,000-\$6,000 per year for their second, third and fourth years of college.

Scholars will also receive summer project grants following their sophomore and junior years of college

Applicants should have a commitment to the liberal arts and have an interest in exploring careers in organizational leadership and management in business or the nonprofit sector.

- Students must be currently in their first year as a fulltime student and may not have reached sophomore status.
- Scholars must maintain a 3.5 grade point average to remain in good standing
- Scholars must display a commitment to helping others and serving society.
- Scholars must demonstrate a capacity for leadership in college.
- Scholars will be selected on the basis of academic achievement and potential, leadership and service, intellectual curiosity and interest in a wide variety of fields, maturity, flexibility and financial need.
