Established in 1974, San Antonio Personnel Management Association (SAPMA) continues to be an integral part of shaping human resource management in the greater San Antonio federal community. We partner with the Alamo Federal Executive Board to strategically build a professional community that meets our membership mutual needs and interests. SAPMA membership participates in community initiatives that strengthens the education foundation in San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas; for example, supporting the Five Palms Elementary School and sponsorship of at least two annual college scholarships.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

SAPMA awards at least one \$1000 scholarship to a deserving student based on the established criteria. In addition, other scholarships may be available in increments of \$500 and/or \$250 depending on funding availability.

STUDENT QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

1. Must be a U. S. Citizen.
2. Enrolled as an official sophomore with 30 semester hours at an accredited college or university in San Antonio, Texas.
3. Major in any field of study.
4. Maintain a 2.5 GPA as an undergraduate and a 3.0 GPA as a graduate applicant.
5. Application forms must be postmarked by July 31, 2007.

SELECTION

1. The SAPMA Scholarship Committee members will review all applications.
2. Applicants must meet all qualification criteria.
3. The school advisor must certify enrollment and GPA.
4. Incomplete applications or those postmarked after the established deadline date will not be considered.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. Scholarship applications will be accepted from students who attend colleges or universities located in San Antonio, Texas. (*).
2. Two copies of the completed application form and transcripts are required. Do not attach additional documents (i.e., letters of recommendation, résumé, etc.).
3. All information will be verified prior to awarding the scholarship.
4. The scholarship recipient(s) and non-recipients will be notified by letter.
5. Notification letters will be mailed to recipients at least 2-3 weeks after the deadline.
6. The scholarship recipients will be recognized during a monthly SAPMA luncheon, held August or September.
