## The Sport Management Program

The Master of Science in Sport Management is designed for people working in a variety of sports organizations. These include National Governing Bodies of Amateur Sports, international organizations such as the International Olympic Committee and its subsidiaries, charitable institutions, professional and amateur sports organizations, as well as college and university athletic departments. Many graduates of sport management programs work in institutions of higher education in the student services area where facilities are managed and physical activities such as intra-murals are pre-programmed and supervised.

## Admission Criteria

Applicants for the Master of Science with majors in Sport Management must meet the general requirements for admission to graduate study. In addition applicants must submit a letter of recommendation from a professional in the field.
