 - Possible children would be slaves




THE PROBLEM OF POWER

- Ethics plays social role






INVERTING FREEDOM AND ETHICS

WHAT IT MEANS

Things

- We enjoy and consume
- Can be possessed
- Are beings

People

- We greet
- Cannot be possessed
- Are 'beyond being'

WHY IS RESPONSIBILITY LIMITLESS?

- Responsibility is not from my decision
- "from the hither side of my freedom"
- "the face is straightaway ethical"
- I am responsible for more than I intend



THE ENTRY OF THE THIRD

- Contradiction is a limit of responsibility
- "What do I have to do with justice?"
- Arbitrating between responsibility is not "constrained to a calculus"

PASSIVITY ETHICS

 Means no violence (no ego) to the other or towards yourself.

 Do onto other as they would do unto themselves

Always infinitely responsible for the other
