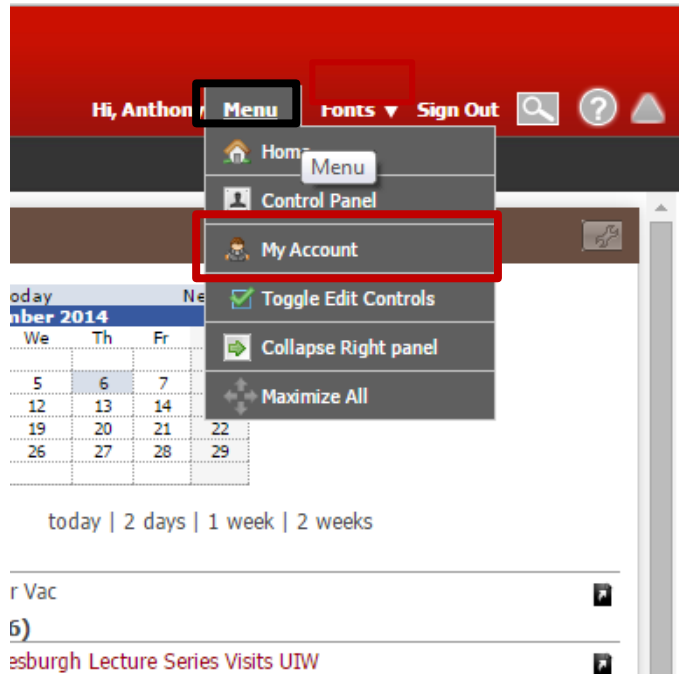
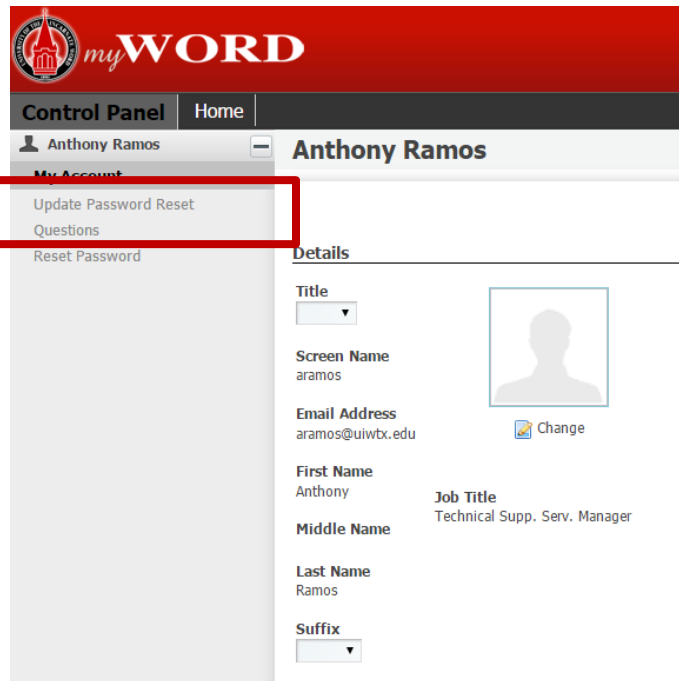


Changing your Security Questions in MyWord
