- Complete and sign application
- Attach the non-refundable \$20.00 application fee to application (check or money order made payable to the University of the Incarnate Word).
- Submit educational documents - All official records of prior programs of study, (high school and university transcripts), translated to English.
- If transferring from another university, please send course descriptions of classes taken, translated to English.
- Submit official TOEFL scores - A minimum score of 560, (computer test - 213), is required. Students whose primary language is English need not take the exam. In some circumstances, the TOEFL requirement may be waived.
- If applying for graduate study, students must submit applicable test score designated by specific graduate program, (GRE, GMAT, or MAT).
- Submit two letters of recommendation. If you attend school in the U.S., you must submit an international student coordinator's report.
- Submit University of the Incarnate Word Health Form. International students are required to carry health Insurance issued by a U.S. carrier, or the university's health insurance plan.
- Submit Visa Information Form.
- Submit Declaration of Finances Form, (including official bank seal or stamp).
- If living on campus, please complete the housing/board agreement and application/questionnaire to the Residence Life Office, along with a \$100.00 deposit.
