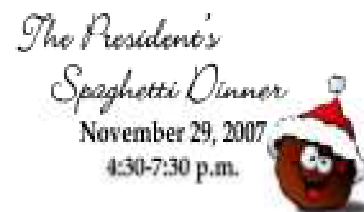
Rave Alert Test: Nov. 30
