TRANSFER ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Effective Fall 2021

All Academic Scholarships are renewable for up to four years provided students maintain satisfactory academic progress.

Presidential Scholarship ---- \$15,000 per year

Eliaibility: GPA of 3.5 - 4.0

Dean's Scholarship ----- \$12,000 per year

Eligibility: GPA of 2.9 - 3.49

Distinguished Scholarship -- \$10,000 per year

Eligibility: GPA of 2.5 - 2.89

Transfer students who are completing their first undergraduate degree and who have completed at least 24 credit hours at an accredited university are automatically considered for Academic Scholarships as part of their application. These scholarships are awarded based on cumulative GPA.

Alamo Colleges Scholarship

\$2,000 per year - Eligibility: Students pursuing their first bachelor's degree, with most recent 24 credit hours from Alamo Colleges and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship

\$2,000 per year - Eligibility: Phi Theta Kappa members with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher. High school students are not eligible for this scholarship.

Academic transcripts are evaluated during the admissions process, at which time eligibility for an academic award is determined.

SUBMIT AN APPLICATION

Students can create a GoUIW profile at **www.uiw.edu.gouiw** to apply, track their application status, and register for Admissions events. They may also apply online through **Apply Texas** and the **Common App**.



SUBMIT ALL TRANSCRIPTS

Students must submit official transcripts from **every institution** they have attended, even if credits show on another transcript as transfer credits. Transcripts must have been printed within the last 12 months.


Students with **fewer than 24 college credits** must also submit an official high school transcript that reflects the student's final GPA and graduation date. Students who graduated from high school fewer than two years ago should also submit **ACT/SAT** scores, if taken.
