What's Next?



Apply for Financial Aid (FAFSA/TASFA)

Apply for financial aid beginning fall 2024 to qualify for state, federal and university grants. Apply online at bit.ly/UIWFAFSA. **UIW's FAFSA code is 003578.**

Confirm Your Attendance

Meet with your admissions counselor to review your financial aid package. When ready, pay your confirmation fee at uiw.edu/confirm (not required for part-time and non-degree-seeking students).

Submit Proof of Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination

Texas state law mandates that all students under the age of 22 entering a Texas college or university provide documentation that they received a bacterial meningitis vaccination within five years preceding their first day of class. You may submit your vaccination record in PDF form to the Office of the Registrar at registrar@uiwtx.edu.

Sign Up for On-Campus Housing (Optional)

Housing is available on campus. View residence halls and apply at uiw.edu/housing with a \$225 deposit.

Take the ALEKS PPL

To be placed in college-level math, students not meeting the minimum requirement may need to take the UIW Mathematics Placement through ALEKS PPL or enroll in a preparatory math course. For more information on staying on track with your degree plan, visit uiw.edu/aleks.

Prepare for Class Registration and Orientation

Once you confirm your attendance, keep an eye on your UIW student email for information on registration and New Student Orientation. Visit uiw.edu/orientation for more information.

Submit Final Official Documents

First-Time-in-College Students: Submit your final high school transcript with the graduation date to admissiondocs@uiwtx.edu or mail official high school transcripts to the address below. Also submit an official college transcript for any dual credit you have received.

Transfer Students: All admitted students must submit official transcripts with final grades from each institution attended before the beginning of the fall semester. Students with fewer than 24 college credit hours are also required to submit an official high school transcript or official GED scores. Final documents may be submitted in PDF format to admissiondocs@uiwtx.edu or physically mailed to the address below.

Admissions FAQ

- **Where can I find my student ID number?**

Your student ID number will be listed in your acceptance letter and your initial acceptance email notification. This number will eventually be visible on your student ID card and you may be asked to provide this ID number during your time as a student.

- **What is New Student Orientation?**

New Student Orientation is a one-day visit to campus where students and parents receive their official welcome to UIW. At orientation, you will attend informative presentations, complete enrollment steps, acquire your student ID card and connect with future classmates.

- **What is Cardinal Apps and how do I access it?**

Cardinal Apps is UIW's online single sign-on portal where you can access your student account and over 30 different applications and resources. Visit Cardinal Apps to view and pay your bill, access your student email account, view your degree plan and more. - **How do I get my course textbooks?**
