2026-2027 FAFSA

Application opened October 2025.

Students apply for the 2026-2027 FAFSA via studentaid.gov

Please note, renewal aid offers will be processed and letters sent in early Spring.

INFORMATION NEEDED TO COMPLETE APPLICATION

- FSA ID for Student and Parent(s)
- 2024 Parent and Student (if applicable) Tax Return
- UIW School Code: 003578

MAINTAINING ELIGIBILITY

Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Requirements:

- Maintain cumulative 2.0 GPA
- Successfully complete 67% of attempted coursework
 Example: If you register for 15 hours, you must complete at least 10 hours
 (10 completed hours / 15 attempted hours = 66.67% completion, rounded up to 67%)
- Not exceed 150% of the number of hours required for graduation

Texas Equalization Grant (TEG) Recipients must also:

- Maintain cumulative 2.5 GPA
- Complete 24 hours and 75% of attempted hours per academic year

GRADUATE & PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL

- •No longer eligible for undergraduate grants & scholarships
 - Also applies to "ABM" programs
- •FAFSA changes to Graduate and student is Independent
- Only eligible for:
 - Unsubsidized Loan
 - Graduate PLUS Loan (grandfathered students only)
 - Private Loans
 - Assistantships
