PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Pastoral Ministry at the College of Humanities, Arts and Social Sciences at the University of the Incarnate Word is offered through a collaborative academic arrangement between the University of the Incarnate Word and the Mexican American Catholic College (MACC) in San Antonio, Texas. The degree prepares students for parish ministry, and for graduate study in ministry or theology. The program emphasizes intercultural competencies, and preparation to work with the diverse populations of the American Southwest.

In keeping with its mission, the program is designed to provide students with a breadth of knowledge in the liberal arts and Catholic culture, offer a solid foundation in biblical and theological studies, ensure language proficiency for ministry in a bilingual pastoral setting and for English-language graduate studies, and equip students with leadership skills and intercultural competencies.

Students can choose between three concentrations:

- Philosophy (Fulfills the requirements for admission to a Catholic seminary program)
- Catechetics
- Catholic Leadership

QUICK FACTS

- The B.A. in Pastoral Ministry program is a collaborative program between UIW and the Mexican American Catholic College (MACC).
- Courses within the major are offered primarily at the MACC campus while Core Curriculum courses are offered at UIW.
- Many Pastoral Ministry majors are Roman Catholic men preparing to enter the seminary and study for the priesthood, however, a number of sisters and lay men and women are also studying to serve in various ministries.
- Supporting students' journeys academically, spiritually and financially is critically important to the Pastoral Institute. As such, all students in this degree program receive the Sr. Eilish Ryan, CCVI Grant, equal to 25% of UIW tuition.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The requirements for admission to the B.A. and B.F.A. programs in Art are the same as the requirements for admission to the University of the Incarnate Word.

Students for whom Spanish is their first language may begin the program before they complete their language exam but may only take Spanish-language courses in the major until that exam is completed.
