### 2024 Global Service Mission Travel Fund

#### Purpose:

To provide financial support for UIW undergraduate, graduate, and/or professional students who are part of a global service mission trip sponsored and/or supported by the Ettling Center for Civic Leadership & Sustainability where service is being conducted to help and support those who are in need or are less fortunate throughout our global community.

#### **Award Components:**

The financial support to an individual student will not exceed \$500 per global mission trip and can be applied to the cost of transportation, airfare, hotel, and meals as part of the mission trip.

### Criteria:

Please complete all sections of the Ettling Center for Civic Leadership & Sustainability Global Service Mission Travel Fund application. Additional documentation may be required prior to approval of the fund request. All completed applications will be reviewed, and notifications of status will be made to each applicant.

The Global Service Mission Travel Fund is part of the Center's continued support to "educate men and women who will become concerned and enlightened citizens within the global community". The funds are earmarked to support service opportunities and experiences supported by the Center for students participating in domestic and/or international travel.

Awards for the Ettling Center for Civic Leadership & Sustainability Global Service Mission Travel Fund are available quarterly, as long as grant funding is available. Allotments may be up to \$500.00 per student per trip.
