The Ettling Center for Civic Leadership with the support of UIW's Student Government Association is able to provide financial support of at least \$500 to UIW undergraduate, graduate and professional students as part of the Ettling Center Legacy Service Travel Fund (ECLSTF).

The purpose of the Ettling Center Legacy Service Travel Fund is to continue the mission and vision of the Sister of Charity of the Incarnate Word by providing and conducting service to populations who are poor, sick or underserved while participating in a domestic (beyond Texas) or international study abroad or service mission trip. Students submitting an application to be considered for the fund should:

- Note in detail the course and/or service activity that will be conducted as part of the domestic or international study abroad or service mission trip;
- Discuss in detail what the student hopes to contribute and gain as a result of the conduction and implementation of the service activity;
- Include information regarding any other funding sources or financial awards that the applicant plans to utilize in addition to the ECLSTF;
- Include in one of the essay responses what the student hopes the entity or people to be served will gain as a result of the conduction and implementation of the service activity;



Fund recipients are awarded at different times throughout the year; thus, students may apply at anytime and please be sure to contact the Ettling Center at least three weeks after submitting your completed application to check on the status of the application. The application may be obtained at:
