Professional Development Requirements:

Students must apply and obtain full acceptance to the Teacher Education Program (TEP) in order to enroll in the professional development courses. TEP acceptance is by cohort with each cohort beginning in the spring semester. Coursework is completed concurrently as noted (spring, fall, clinical teaching). Effective March 15, 2017, the Texas Education Agency will require a \$55.00 fee per teacher candidate made payable to UIW upon acceptance to the Teacher Education Program.
