### Professional Development Requirements:

*Students must apply and obtain full acceptance to the Teacher Education Program (TEP) to enroll in the professional development courses. TEP acceptance is by cohort with each cohort beginning in the spring semester. Courses are completed concurrently as noted (spring, fall, clinical teaching). Effective the 2017-2018 academic year, the Texas Education Agency will require a \$35.00 fee per teacher candidate upon acceptance to the Teacher Education Program.
