**Application Process:**

- Finalize your admissions with UIW.** Students must be admitted to be considered for aid.
- Complete the 2018-2019 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)**  
**Create an FSA ID Online: <https://fsaid.ed.gov>**  
**FAFSA Application Online: <https://fafsa.ed.gov> Students must apply for FAFSA each year**  
**Use your 2016 Tax Information to complete the FAFSA Application**  
**Send your application to UIW using 003578 in the school code section**
- Receive your results.** The electronic FAFSA process takes 3-5 days. Once we receive your FAFSA results, we will send you notification of next steps by mail or e-mail.

**Basic Eligibility Requirements:**

- Undergraduate students **must enroll full-time** (minimum of 12 credit hours per semester) in main campus coursework to receive UIW Grants, UIW Scholarships, State grants and/or Federal grants (other than Pell). **UIW grants and scholarships may be applied towards tuition only.**
- Students are required to maintain satisfactory academic progress in order to continue to use financial aid. In general, students need to be completing at least 75% of their courses with a minimum 2.0 gpa.
- Undergraduate students must enroll at least half-time** (minimum 6 credit hours per semester) in a degree-seeking program to receive federal loans, work-study or Pell grant (if eligible).

**Additional Costs:**

- Health Insurance:** Students are required to purchase health insurance unless covered. The health insurance cost for the 17-18 year was \$1,245. Students are automatically charged health insurance, but can waive the charge by providing proof of health insurance electronically to the Business Office.
- Parking:** Parking permits range from \$250 for commuters to \$680 for residents, for the year.

**Quick Facts:**

- UIW has banded tuition – your tuition cost remains the same for 12-18 credit hours!
- Merit scholarships are awarded in the admissions process without an additional application.
- 99% of students receive some form of financial assistance at UIW.
- UIW’s default rate is 6.7%, which is well below the national average.
