The Scanlan Foundation Scholarship is designated to provide tuition assistance to undergraduate students pursing a degree in a health professional programs such as: Nursing, Nuclear Medicine, Community Health Education, and pre-professional degree programs for Optometry, Osteopathic Medicine, Pharmacy, and Physical Therapy.

The scholarship must be divided between the Fall and Spring semesters, and can only be applied towards tuition. Please complete this application and return to the Office of Financial Assistance for consideration by <u>June 12, 2020.</u>

Students must meet the following criteria to apply:

- Must have completed 60+ hours at the end of Spring 2020, with a minimum cumulative 2.75 GPA
- Must be pursuing a degree in a health professional program
- Must be enrolled full-time enrollment (12+ hours) to receive the scholarship each semester
- Must submit a 2020-2021 FAFSA and demonstrate financial need, determined by the FAFSA.
- Must be in good academic standing and maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress

Please attach the following items to the Scanlan Foundation Scholarship application:

- Personal Biography
 - Submit a typed personal biography detailing why you chose to attend UIW, your career goals and plans after obtaining your degree, and any hardships/obstacles encountered.
- Thank You Letter
