Institutional Scholarship Information

Freshman Merit Award

Students applying to university for the first time directly from high school. Awards are given based on high school grades and SAT or ACT test scores. The awards range from \$5,000 - \$20,000 per year and are renewable after the first year if a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 is maintained.

Catholic High School Award

Any student that is applying as a freshman and graduates from a Catholic High School is eligible for a \$2,000 award. This award is renewable for up to four years as long as a minimum GPA of 3.0 is maintained.

Endowed Scholarship

Applicants must be either returning UIW students who have earned a minimum 3.6 cumulative grade point average OR high school students who meet the academic scholarship criteria established by the Admissions Office. The application is available through Financial Aid and has a March/April deadline each year.

Transfer Merit Award

Any student that is applying with a minimum of 24 credits is considered a transfer student. All transfer students are automatically eligible for an academic scholarship based on their cumulative GPA. These awards range from \$10,000 - \$15,000 and are renewable after the first year if a minimum GPA of 3.0 is maintained.

Central/South American Scholarship

Undergraduate students applying to UIW from within their home country in the regions of Central and South American will be considered for a 20% tuition discount. Only students applying to UIW from within their home country and independently of a recruiting agent are eligible.

South Pacific Scholarship

Undergraduate students applying to UIW from within their home country of Indonesia, Philippines or Vietnam will be considered for a 20% tuition discount. Only students applying to UIW from within their home country and independently of a recruiting agent are eligible.

Sister School Alumni Scholarship

Students who have received a Bachelor's degree from one of UIW's sister school partners will receive a 20% tuition discount towards a Master's degree at UIW. This award does not apply to students who are part of special programs, cohorts, and/or recruited by third parties.
