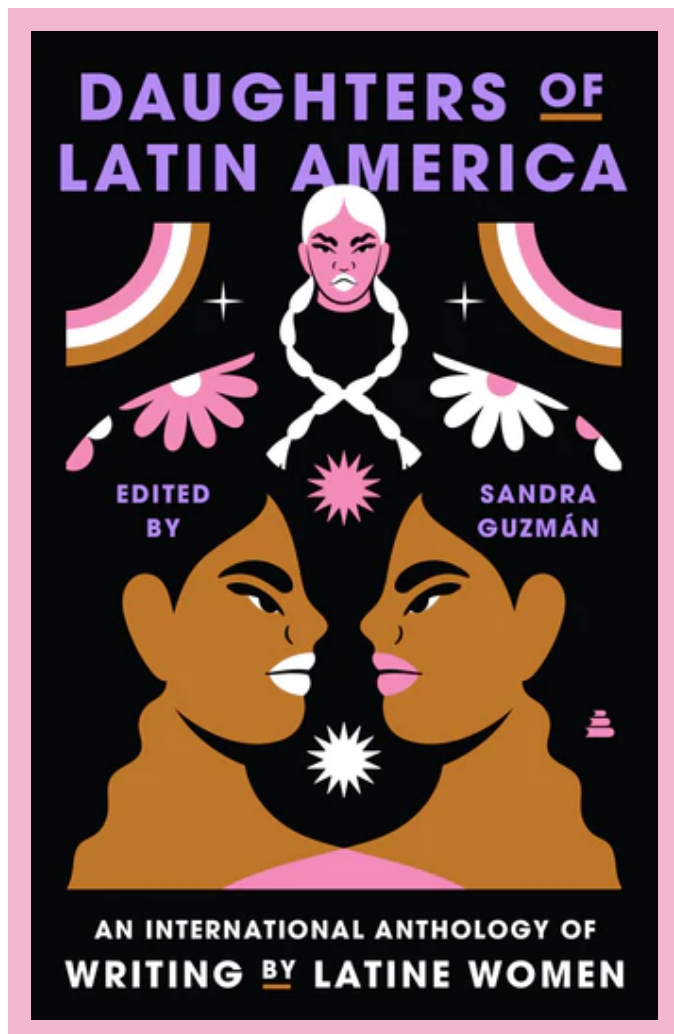

The second discussion is an intermediate-level Spanish class set for 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 5th in AD 245. Alternative larger locations may be arranged depending on numbers. Please note that the Wednesday discussion will be in English, while the Thursday session will be a mixture of Spanish and English. Many students already enrolled in the sessions have been working with Sandra's anthology as part of their coursework this semester, but familiarity with the book is not required. The purpose of the discussion sessions is to help students explore and understand the intriguing intersection of storytelling and service.
