Bachelor of Science in Leadership Studies

The Bachelor of Science in Leadership Studies gives graduates the practical knowledge and experience to lead positive changes in the workplace as well as their community. The program was designed to give students the expertise to understand, analyze, and model skills needed in a broad range of organizations such as business management, government, and non-profit. In addition, students can customize the degree to their personal career choice. Students are required to add a minor that will direct their studies for enhanced career opportunities.¹

Major Requirements for a Bachelor of Science in Leadership Studies

1. Completion of UIW General Education Core Curriculum (46 hours)

* All 15 hours of General Education will transfer here if applicable, plus 3 hours of transfer credit from the CCAF degree plan

2. Leadership Studies Major (30 semester hours of Leadership-related coursework)

3. Required Minor (12-21 hours)

* Students must select one or two minors from any approved EAP minor (Business Administration 21SH, Criminal Justice 15SH, Health Care Management 15SH, Human Resource Management 18SH, Industrial and Organizational Psychology 18SH, Leadership Studies 15SH, Nonprofit Management 15SH, Organizational Communication 12SH, Organizational Development 18SH, Operations Management 18SH, Project Management 18SH, Psychology 18SH). Twelve to twenty-one hours of one or two minors in a related area of concentration. If applicable, all or some of the 12-21 hours of required minor will transfer here.

4. Second Minor/General Elective Module (23-32 hours)

* Free elective hours. Students will choose a second minor from approved EAP minor (Business Administration 21SH, Criminal Justice 15SH, Health Care Management 15SH, Human Resource Management 18SH, Industrial and Organizational Psychology 18SH, Leadership Studies 15SH, Nonprofit Management 15SH, Organizational Communication 12SH, Organizational Development 18SH, Operations Management 18SH, Project Management 18SH, Psychology 18SH), or transfer hours. If applicable, all or some of the 23-32 hours of required minor will transfer here. Program Electives and Technical Education can transfer in here as free electives.

5. Community Service Component

A total of 45 clock hours (non-credit) of Community Service are required for all baccalaureate degrees at UIW. Academic advisors discuss the options for fulfilling the community service requirement and the method for documenting the service.

6. Residency Requirement

Following SOC guidelines, completion of 25% (30 credit hours) of course work at the University of the Incarnate Word for Baccalaureate degree programs.

7. Upper-Division Course Requirement

36 hours of upper-division course work (3000-level and above). These courses can be transferred in or taken at UIW.
