Organization of the Fashion Industry:

The course presents how the industry is organized from manufacturing to retailing. Including how the industry is aligned by pricing strategies used by retailers. **Supplies needed:** Personal notetaking materials

Pattern alterations: We will spend 3 hours covering how to alter commercial patterns. Bring with you common problems you have with your students and some commercial patterns to alter. **Supplies needed:** Personal notetaking materials. **Class supply fee:** \$5 for handouts & in-class supply usage

Creative Problem Solving:

In this class, we will learn how to apply proven creative tools to everyday problems and applications. Use these techniques to develop your curriculum or teach the tools directly to your students to help prepare them for a world full of complicated issues. The class is highly interactive, so be ready to push up your sleeves. Laughter comes free of charge! **Supplies needed:** personal notetaking materials. **Class supply fee:** \$5 for handouts & in-class supply usage

Adobe Photoshop and Illustrator for Fashion Mood Boards:

Use the basic tools of Adobe Photoshop and Illustrator to create a fashion mood board. In this class we will focus on learning the primary tools and features in the two most common Adobe applications for the fashion industry. By the end of this course, you will be able to create your own fashion mood board and help your students to accomplish the same in your own class. **Supplies needed:** Personal notetaking materials

Textile Refresher:

This textile refresher course provides a broad view of the development, production, and utilization of fabrics and their impact on design, construction, and the environment. This class will include hands-on lab demonstrations to identify fibers, weaves and finishes. **Supplies needed:** personal notetaking materials. **Class supply fee:** \$5 for handouts & in-class supply usage

Classes are only open to individuals 18 years and older. Participants do not receive college credit for these classes.
