	TOEFL IBT: 79; 22 for Writing	
English Language	For postgraduate study:	
	IELTS: 6.5; 6.0 in all sections	
	TOEFL IBT: 90; 25 for Writing	
	Please note: students wishing to take units within the Law, Nursing and Education programs may be required to have a higher level of English proficiency. Full entry requirements are listed in Schedule 3 of the <u>ACU Handbook</u> .
