and

Non-Straight Exchange Sister Schools

The University of the Incarnate Word (UIW) strives to provide as many study abroad opportunities to students, faculty, and the academic community. As such, UIW has partnered with over 145 sister schools in over 45 countries. Out of the many sister schools, a few are characterized as non-straight exchange sister schools.

Straight Exchange sister schools are partner institutions where exchange students pay their tuition fees to their home university, not to the host institution. However, students need to be able to cover the costs incurred by studying abroad such as room and board, travel expenses, health insurance, and other fees (dependent on institution).

Non-straight exchange sister schools are partner institutions which charge tuition and other fees *versus* straight exchange sister schools in which exchange students pay their tuition to their home university.

Due to the non-straight exchange sister school charging tuition and other fees, institutional scholarships (i.e., Academic Scholarships, etc.) may <u>not</u> be applied. Though certain institutional scholarships may not be applicable for non-straight exchange sister schools, students are encouraged to visit with the Financial Aid Office to discuss their financial aid options.
