Online Nomination for Partners	Autumn Semester and Full Academic Year: 17 th April – 19 th May 2023 Spring Semester: 25 th September – 20 th October 2023 *Academic year is from September 23 to July 24 Nomination will be only by Mobility Online.
Online Application for Students	Autumn Semester or Full Academic Year: 17 th April – 2 nd June 2023 Spring Semester and extensions: 25 th September – 27 th October 2023 Learning Agreement is compulsory and must be sent with the online application.
	ITERNSHIP'S NOMINATION AND APPLICATION PROCEDURES (NEW!)
Online Nomination for Partners	Autumn Semester and Full Academic Year: 17 th April – 19 th May 2023 (for internships that it will take place from September to December) Spring Semester: 25 th September – 20 st October 2023 (for internships that it takes place from January to July) Applications out these deadlines will not be admitted. Internships are not eligible in August. Nomination will be only by Mobility Online.

	UFV REQUIREMENTS FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS
Language Requirements	As the teaching language at UFV is Spanish, we require a B1 level. B2 is highly advisable in Communication Studies. A B2 level is required for students wishing to follow English-taught courses, only available in some study areas with limited spots. Traineeships: students of Nursing, Physiotherapy and Medicine must hold at least a B2/C1 level of Spanish.
Intensive/ Semester-long Spanish Language Courses	Intensive Spanish Course (ECTS to be determined) Available before the start of each semester depending on the number of applicants. (More information about fees and details will be sent upon successful completion of our online application.) More information, registration and tuition fees: idiomas@ufv.es Semester-long Spanish Course (6 ECTS) All levels (basic/intermediate/advanced) available for free to all international students. (*Please note that you must complete a Spanish level test upon arrival.)
