HOCHSCHULE HEIDELBERG

Double Degree

UIW undergraduate business majors with concentrations in Management, General Business, and International Business are eligible to participate in this program and earn a UIW Bachelor of Business and BA International Bachelor of Business from SRH Hochschule University.

Students are required to take specific business courses during 2 semesters at SRH Hochschule, Heidelberg, Germany.

Upon returning and successfully completing their UIW undergraduate business degree in San Antonio, SRH Hochschule will award the BA International Bachelor of Business.

Eligibility, you must have:



- Valid passport and eligible to travel internationally for a year
- Full time undergraduate business student in good standing
- Business concentration in Management, General Business, or International Business
- Successfully completed required UIW courses (see next slide)
- Willing to make new friends, explore new cultures, and invest in your future success

*Additionally, students will be required to complete a 60-day internship and thesis for their SRH BA.



Internship & Thesis Requirements

- The internship must have a duration of 60 working days, and the thesis must be completed afterwards (thesis to be completed in 2-4 months).
- Both must be conducted under an SRH supervisor
- Your internship and thesis can be done anywhere in the world!
- You may decide to complete your internship during your semester breaks, on weekends, or add another semester. It does not have to be done during your time at SRH.

Student VISA

- U.S. students <u>do not</u> require a visa to study in Germany!
- After your arrival, SRH representatives will help you in arranging your residency.
- Stress-free process!



Getting to Heidelberg, Germany is easy!



12 – 13 hours from San Antonio (SAT) to Frankfurt Int'l Airport (FRA).

About 1 hour by bus or train from Frankfurt to Heidelberg.

Have you thought about what you do in a period of 15 hours lately?

Is 15 hours going to keep you from creating a lifetime of memories (and 2 degrees)?

A home away from home

- SRH Hochschule offers oncampus housing, but be aware that early application is required (housing is not guaranteed)
- Cafeteria and eating areas are located throughout campus
- Cafés are just about everywhere in the city



Convenient Amenities

SRH offers close to 600 affordable accommodations to students.

Wieblingen is a Heidelberg suburb in the west of the city on the banks of the Neckar. The apartments here are centrally located in a quiet neighborhood.

There is a wide range of sports activities and health services directly on the SRH campus, as well as shops and bus / tram stops within walking distance.

The river Neckar is only a few minutes' walk away, and the romantic city center of historic Heidelberg is a mere ten minutes away by bike.





Cost

- You pay the same tuition to UIW!
- Financial aid, scholarships, and grants apply!

Estimated cost, **per semester**:

- Room & Board: 5,000
- Living Expenses: 1,000
- Health Insurance: 250
- Books: 250
- Air Ticket: one time cost 1,200
 Sub Total: 7,700



Next Steps

- Contact your academic advisor in the HEB School of Business to discuss your degree plan and courses you will need to take at UIW and SRH.
- Schedule a time to visit with a Study Abroad Representative or the Director of International Affairs.
- Apply for a Passport or ensure it is valid for an additional year from the dates you intend to participate.

Timeline

Immediately get your passport or ensure your passport is valid after one year of your intended participation

Number of months before your intended start date:

- <u>12-8</u>: Visit with your academic advisor to discuss your courses and what you will need to take
- <u>9-7</u>: Visit with the Study Abroad & Exchange Coordinator or the Director of International Affairs and start your study abroad application online
- <u>7-6</u>: Study abroad office officially nominates you
- <u>6-5</u>: Complete your study abroad application online and request to study abroad form, and apply to SRH Hochschule



Timeline, cont.

Number of months before your intended start date:

- <u>5-4</u>: Receive your acceptance letter and start your student visa application process
- <u>4-3</u>: Submit your student visa application to the German Consulate General. Also, during this time apply for student housing at SRH Hochschule
- <u>3-2</u>: Upon receiving your visa, purchase your airfare
- <u>2-1</u>: Visit with the Study Abroad & Exchange Coordinator or Director of International Affairs to confirm any final details
- 1 month to the last weeks before departure should be dedicated to any personal errands because you're ALL SET TO GO!
